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MESSAGE FROM CHAIRPERSON

Operation  Smile
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Over the past year, we have made remarkable strides in our surgical missions throughout Thailand. We have completed a total of **18,561 life-changing treatments**

since our inception, assisting children with cleft lips and palates, as well as burn and facial deformity patients, in reclaiming their smiles, confidence, and ability to flourish within their communities. In 2025, **311 surgeries** were performed.

We also added a new challenge by **funding a “cleft camp”** for 160 patients and their families, to enhance overall patient development and inspire patients to positively and aspiringly navigate in the real world. On our School Programs, we **visited 5 schools with a total of 1,320 teenage** students during our 4 Short Term Surgical Programs in order to raise awareness about cleft conditions and prevention. At present, Operation Smile Thailand **empowers smiles through 39 School Clubs**. We strive to ensure that no child is left behind and reinforce the importance of early intervention in these life-changing treatments.



KEY ACHIEVEMENT

In 2025, Operation Smile Thailand made a meaningful impact through life-changing medical care for children and prevention workshops in secondary schools, which educated the students about the causes of clefts and prevention. We provided funding and developed projects to improve our patients' quality of life in the long term.

Also, add a new challenge by funding 1 "cleft camp" to ensure development among patients and families. This camp could inspire patients to balance their lives in the real world. We top up our challenge by visiting 6 schools during the Short Term Surgical Program in order to raise awareness and educate about cleft conditions. For School Programs, Operation Smile Thailand empowers smiles with more School Clubs. We ensure that no child is left behind and reinforce the importance of early intervention in these life-changing treatments.

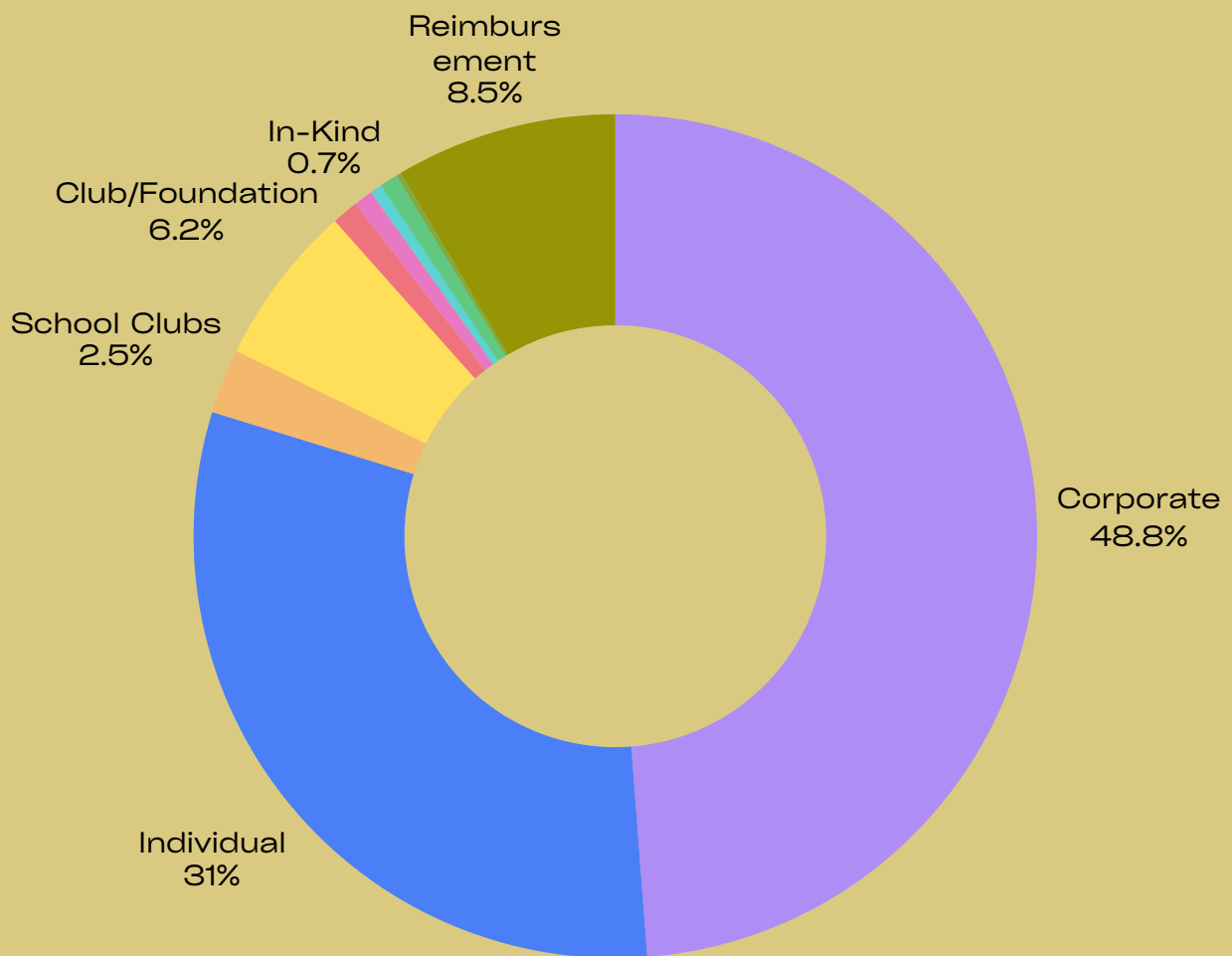
